After the visit to the Canyon, Fina and Peter drove to have some lunch at a nearby lodge, where they would stay for the night.


Welcome

How many horses can you see?




On day five, Fina and Peter headed to a small town called **Lüderitz.** On the way they saw the wide open spaces of the **desert and more wild horses.**


